

# NOK Fukushima Plant Partners with Fukushima City's "Tekishio" Initiative

Encouraging Healthy Eating with Low-Sodium Menu Options

NOK Corporation (Headquarters: Shibadaimon, Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, Group Chief Executive Officer: Masao Tsuru; hereinafter referred to as "NOK") is collaborating with Fukushima City's salt reduction initiative "Tekishio" to offer Tekishio meal options in the employee cafeteria at NOK's Fukushima Plant (located in Fukushima City, Fukushima Prefecture) from January to March 2025.

Tekishio is a key part of Fukushima City's Healthy City Fukushima Project, which strives to create a supportive food environment to promote better individual health. As part of this initiative, NOK helps its employees maintain healthy eating habits while encouraging overall wellness.

Since November last year, NOK's Fukushima Plant has been registered as a Tekishio Supporter and now offers a Tekishio meal option on its employee cafeteria menu. January, February and March have been designated as "Tekishio months." During this time, one of the four daily options on the cafeteria menu will be a Tekishio meal containing only 2.5 grams of salt, while the remaining options will use reduced-sodium seasonings. The Tekishio meal was developed with the cooperation of Fukushima City.

To help establish healthy eating habits and raise employee awareness, the plant has set up displays to provide information about salt reduction and deepen understanding. Employee feedback is also being collected through surveys to improve the initiative further.

NOK's Fukushima Plant will continue collaborating with Fukushima City to advance Tekishio activities and support employee health and wellness.

# Examples of "Tekishio" Options Offered at NOK Fukushima Plant

- Sautéed chicken with sesame sauce, stir-fried *konjac* and *takana* (Japanese mustard greens) in a spicy sauce, barley rice, and soup
- Sweet and sour pork with a full serving of vegetables, seaweed salad, rice with konjac, and soup
- Lemon teriyaki chicken, broccoli with mustard mayonnaise, 15-grain rice, and soup
- Marinated cod, simmered *hijiki* (seaweed), barley rice, and soup
- Grilled pork and vegetable marinade, stir-fried green peppers with eggs, rice with konjac, and soup
