

NOK Extends Uniform Partnership with Fukushima United FC for Fourth Year

Supporting Regional Growth and Youth Development

NOK Corporation (Headquarters: Shibadaimon, Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, Group Chief Executive Officer: Masao Tsuru; hereinafter referred to as "NOK") will continue its uniform partnership with AC Fukushima United (Headquarters: Fukushima City, Fukushima Prefecture; Representative Director: Hayato Suzuki; hereinafter referred to as "Fukushima United FC") for the 2025 season. Now in its fourth year, the partnership will see NOK's newly redesigned logo, introduced in April 2024, featured on the uniform's collarbone area.

As part of its ongoing commitment to regional revitalization and youth development, NOK will also provide the gymnasium at its Fukushima Plant as a new training venue for Fukushima United FC starting this season.

The 2025 J-League season marks NOK's eighth year as an official club partner of Fukushima United FC. NOK will serve as the matchday sponsor for the Meiji Yasuda J3 League Round 29 game against AC Nagano Parceiro on Sunday, September 28, at Toho Minna-no-Stadium in

Fukushima City. As part of its commitment to regional revitalization, NOK will also support community events, including a soccer clinic for local children.

This season, NOK is launching a new initiative by providing the gymnasium at its Fukushima Plant as a training venue. It will be used by the first team, academy teams (U-18 and U-15), and school programs for younger children. By offering this space, NOK aims to support the development of the next generation of soccer players, helping them grow and pursue their dreams through sports.

As a dedicated partner in revitalizing Fukushima, NOK remains committed to supporting Fukushima United FC throughout the 2025 season as the club pushes for promotion to J2, the second division in the Japanese league.
